WHAT IS HAPPENING IN....

Kindergarten:

1st Grade: The first grade students will learn about Lazarus being raised from the dead, Germany, and muscles. They will also work with math fact families and 100 facts speed drills. They will practice capitalization, locating the complete subject and complete predicate, synonyms and antonyms, and will work on spelling list J-5.

2nd & 3rd Grades: The second and third graders will learn about David's sin with Bathsheba and the birth of Christ. The second grade students will work on subtracting with two-digit numbers and multiplying by 3 and 6. The third grade students will continue working with simple sentences, fragments, and run-ons. They will also learn about compound sentences.

4th & 5th Grades: The fourth and fifth graders will study the end of the American Revolution and the winter at Valley Forge. They will continue reading *Yankee Doodle Boy*, write book reviews, and will learn about the animal kingdom. The fourth graders will learn how to manipulate fractions, percents, and decimals. The fifth graders will practice using participles, gerunds, and infinitives.
